A dedication of the new fishing pier located on the Mattaponi River, Mattaponi was held on Friday evening at 5:00 P.M. Members present were Ms. Alsop, Mr. Bailey and Mr. Simpkins. Others in attendance were Delegate Keith Hodges, VMRC representative and County Administrator Thomas Swartzwelder.

It is noted that no other county business was discussed.

Facts about the Pier are as follows:

- Construction Cost of Pier: \$150,000.00 - 80/20 grant was received through Virginia Marine Resource Commission
- Contractor: Charles Duke, Waterfront Development, Inc., Gloucester, Virginia
- Property was acquired from VDOT several years ago
- Several years ago, survey was included in the tax bills asking for citizen input as to what they would like to see happen in King and Queen County. The top two (2) things were: Broadband and a Fishing Pier. Both of these have now been accomplished.
- Size of Pier: 65 feet long with a 15 x 30 “T” head.
- A Salt Water Fishing License for the pier has been bought by the County
