The June Primary election has been moved to June 23, 2020, upon the signing of Governor Northam executive order.

General Register has contacted Officer Elections, shortage of workers needed due to COVID-19. More workers are needed for the June 2020 election.

The General Registrar needs personal protection items for all precincts; disinfecting wipes, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant spray.

L&A Testing and sealing of voting equipment has been delayed. General Registrar and Assistant General Registrar will complete the testing.

All precincts were available for the June 9, 2020 Primary election, and will contact again before the June 23, 2020 election.

All voters are encouraged to vote by mail for the June Primary election. Voters are to use code 2A disability or illness. Applications can be completed online at <https://www.elections.virginia.gov> or request application from the Registrar's office.

As of today, 25 absentee applications have been received.

General Registrar forwarded an email to the Electoral Board members of the 2020 Election Legislation, effective July 1, 2020.
