New Business

Board Of Supervisor meeting is scheduled for February 25, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Electoral Board Chairman will attend along with the General Registrar.

General Registrar updated Electoral Board members on the Legislative Review. There is a bill in the General Assembly that is likely going to be passed which allows for no excuse early voting for 7 days prior to an election. Absentee voting; no excuse in-person voting available beginning on the second Saturday immediately preceding election. The provisions of the bill do not become effective until November 3, 2020. There is a push in the General Assembly to implement November 2019. It will likely have a financial impact on our locality, which was not included in the budget.

Electoral Board organization for term March 1, 2019 - February 28, 2020: Mary Ann Levere has accepted reappointment of Secretary. All other appointments remain as is.

Ballot images must be retained on a V-drive for 22 months after an election.

If held, June 11, 2019 is the scheduled date for the Primary election.

The Electoral Board will not meet during the month of March, next meeting is scheduled for April 9th, 2019 at 8:30 a.m.
