Old Business

The General Registrar is checking all voting equipment in conjunction with the Hart Prevention Maintenance schedule. The General Registrar will purchase backup cell batteries and rechargeable batteries, printer toner and security keys based on budget.

Local candidate packages are due in the General Registrar's office by June 11, 2019 by 7:00 pm. As of today's date she has received five certified packages.

The FY2020 office budget has been approved by the King and Queen Board of Supervisors.

The General Registrar has talked with the County Administrator about a larger van for transporting voting equipment for the November election. Equipment needs to be upright and not stacked. He is ok with asking the School Board for the use of their van for the November election.

New Business

The General Registrar term expires June 30, 2019. The Electoral Board will complete the necessary paperwork for reinstatement.

The General Registrar passed out to the Electoral Board members, legislation on No Excuse Early Voting, effective November 2020.
