The General Registrar passed out copies of the approved 20/21 Budget to Board members for Electoral Board and General Registrar.

June Primary is a Dual Primary.. The General Register has mailed out 128 absentee ballots, 83 has been returned as of today's date.

The General Registrar and Electoral Board members reviewed the Officer of Elections and Electoral Board assignments for the election on Tuesday, June 23, 2020. Mary Ann Levere will start the morning at precinct 101, David Broaddus at 201 and Armistead Ransone will assist the General Registrar at the office.

On Monday, June 22, 2020, starting at 9:00 a.m. Deputy Jorgenson and Armistead Ransone will deliver the voting equipment and supplies to all precincts.

Voters are encouraged to vote by mail, use code 2A-disability or illness. Last day to request an application is June 16, 2020. Applications can be completed online at <https://www.elections.virginia.gov>, or request from the Registrar's office.

The Department of Elections in person training has been cancelled. Online training has been scheduled for July 20, 2020 and July 21, 2020.

The General Registrar and Electoral Board members have agreed a satellite office will be needed for the November, 2020 election. The satellite office will open seven days prior to the election. More information to follow.
