Review of minutes from the April 13, 2021 meeting were reviewed and approved.

The General Registrar has purchased new Election Poll Books and will be used in the November election.

The Democratic Party primary will be held June 8, 2021, Absentee voting starts April 23, 2021. As of today, four people have voted in person, forty nine absentee ballots has been mailed and seven has been returned.

The General Registrar passed out an updated list of the Officers of Election. Training will be held on May 27, 2021. Mary Levere will pick up food for training.

On Monday June 7, 2021, Deputy Burton and Armistead Ransone will deliver the voting equipment and supplies to all precincts.

On election day, Mary Ann Levere will start the morning at precinct 101, Mellisa South at precinct 301 and Armistead Ransone at precinct 401.

Provisional and Canvass meetings will be held June 9th and Board members may need to meet again on Friday, June 11, 2021.
