

JOINT PRESS RELEASE

KING AND QUEEN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS and the KING AND QUEEN COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

The King and Queen County Board of Supervisors and the King and Queen County School Board are pleased to announce acquisition of a 61.04 acre parcel of real property adjoining the Central High School real estate, together forming a 90-acre education campus. With the acquisition of this real property, the Board of Supervisors and the School Board have formed a strategic partnership to design and construct a state-of-the-art campus and to elevate the educational opportunities available to the students of King and Queen County Public Schools. This collaboration will benefit the students with broadened academic opportunities, better facilities, and an innovative environment and culture for student instruction.

The immediate next steps are (1) the development of a master site plan, and (2) the construction of an elementary school to replace the lower school. The goal is to have a site plan in place by spring of 2025 with elementary school construction to begin shortly thereafter. As this project develops, public meetings will be held and additional information will be shared.
