



## **King and Queen County Awards Grimm + Parker Architects Contract for School Schematic Design and Wetland Delineation**

**King and Queen County, VA – March 4, 2026**– King and Queen County has awarded [Grimm + Parker Architects](#) the contract to develop the schematic design and wetlands delineation for construction of a new elementary school and academic campus. The project will proceed with further stakeholder engagement and public input opportunities to ensure that the final plan aligns with the needs and vision of King and Queen County leaders and citizens alike. The county continues to provide real-time project updates through the county website, social media, and Board of Supervisors meeting reports.

A work group, comprised of key stakeholders, has met and engaged with Grimm + Parker to continue the work begun during the master site plan phase of this project. The schematic design phase will include determination for quantities and sizes of all spaces, as well as a complete school site plan and floor plan, based on the foundational work completed in the Master Planning Site Study.

“We are excited to continue working with Grimm + Parker Architects as we continue to develop this state of the art learning environment for the students of King and Queen County,” said Mark Berry, Board of Supervisors Chairman.

The new school will be built on a 61-acre parcel acquired by King and Queen County in 2024. The property adjoins the existing King and Queen Central High School campus, forming a 91-acre educational hub designed to facilitate shared resources, extracurricular collaboration, and long-term educational planning. The new school is currently anticipated to open for student occupancy in the fall of 2028.
