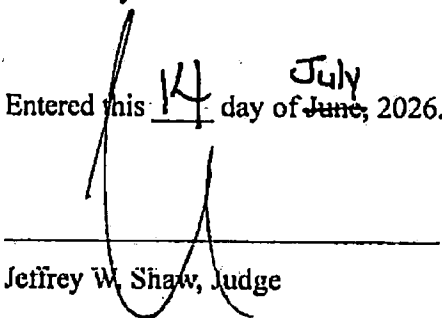

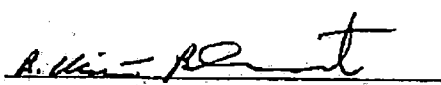
ORDER ADOPTING LOCAL RULES
GOVERNING PETITIONS FOR SEALING CRIMINAL RECORDS

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 8.01-4 and Rule 1:15 of the Rules of the Virginia Supreme Court, the judges of the Ninth Judicial Circuit unanimously adopt the below Local Rule, having determined it is necessary to promote efficiency in matters before the Ninth Judicial Circuit Courts.

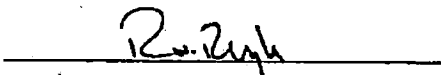
In all Petitions to Seal Criminal Records pursuant to Virginia Code Sections 19.2-392.12 and 19.2-392.12:1, the petitioner shall employ the standardized forms promulgated by the Office of the Executive Secretary. Such forms will be available beginning July 1, 2026 on the Virginia Judicial System Website.

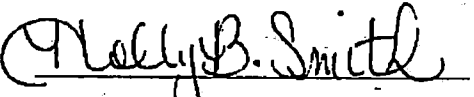

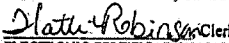
