ORDER OF PUBLICATION

This matter comes before the Clerk upon Plaintiff's affidavit seeking service by publication under Virginia Code §§ 8.01-316 and 8.01-317. The Clerk finds that the requirements for service by publication have been established.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that the following defendants shall appear and protect their interests in this action on or before November 25, 2026, which date is not fewer than fifty (50) days after entry of this Order:

1. The Unknown Heirs, Devisees, and Successors in Title of Margaret Christine Holmes Burse Bundley, deceased;
2. The Unknown Heirs, Devisees, and Successors in Title of George Wiley Holmes, deceased;
3. The Unknown Heirs, Devisees, and Successors in Title of Nettie Pearlina Holmes Smith, deceased;
4. The Unknown Heirs, Devisees, and Successors in Title of Catherine Holmes Muse, deceased;

5. The Unknown Heirs, Devisees, and Successors in Title of Fannie Cook Brockenbrough, deceased; and

6. Parties Unknown, if any, who may claim any right, title, estate, lien, or interest in the Property.

The object of this action is to determine all ownership and other interests in the Property and to obtain partition, allotment, or sale of the Property, together with related equitable relief. The Property is approximately 35.25 acres in the Buena Vista Magisterial District of King & Queen County, Virginia, identified as Tax Map No. 23 161L 1431, Account No. 3408-1, and commonly associated with 00 Devils Three Jump Road, Little Plymouth, Virginia.

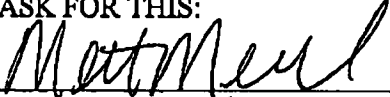
It is further ORDERED that this Order shall be published once each week for four successive weeks in the Tidewater Review, a newspaper qualified under Virginia Law and having general circulation in King and Queen County, posted at the front door of the courthouse, and otherwise processed in accordance with Virginia Code § 8.01-317.

It is further ORDERED that, because this is a partition action in which an order of publication is sought, Plaintiff shall post and maintain, while this action is pending, a conspicuous sign on the Property not later than ten (10) days after entry of this Order. The sign shall state that this action has commenced, identify this Court and its address, and identify the Property by its common designation. The Court may require Plaintiff to include Plaintiff's name and the known defendants' names on the sign.
